SB 2542 (Marrero, B.) HB 2574 (Hackworth)	Prohibits social security numbers from being included on medical records prepared for electronic storage or transmission	Current Status	Support
SB 2511 (Marrero, B.) HB 2562 (Richardson)	Enacts the "Safe Access to Medical Cannabis Act"	Current Status	Support
SB 1973 (Norris) HB 2189 (DeBerry)	Public Records - Makes confidential information regarding a public employee's health savings account, retirement account, and pension account.	Current Status	Support
SB 1934 (Burchett) HB 1426 (Niceley)	Prohibits state from being required to participate in the implementation of the federal REAL ID Act of 2005, which mandates a national identification card for each citizen of the United States	Current Status	Support
SB 1545 (Burchett) HB 2100 (Towns)	Makes it an unfair or deceptive act for an entity to request a person's social security number. Permits the request to be made in certain circumstances if the state or federal government requires it or if the number is to be used for employment verification	Current Status	Support
SB 0887 (Ketron) HB 0847 (Mumpower)	Authorizes filing offices to redact social security numbers from recorded documents	Current Status	Support

SB 0582 (Henry) HB 0618 (Sontany)	Prohibits a business or other entity from printing a consumer's social security number on a card or badge if the consumer has to display that card in order to obtain goods or services to which the consumer is entitled	Current Status	Support
SB 0153 (Kentron) HB 2059 (Lynn)	Classifies as a Class A misdemeanor, subject to a fine only, the unauthorized implantation of an electronic identification and/or tracking device or mark placed on any human being	Current Status	Support
