SB1911 HB1839	Jackson Tidwell	S:Education H:Education	Education, Higher - Prohibits the state higher education institutions from using or including sexual orientation, sexual preference or transgender status in admissions criteria, rules or policies. – Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 7, Part 1.	Oppose
SB1621 HB2114	Black S. Jones, et al	S:Education H:Education	Education, Curriculum – Requires each public school to adopt a policy addressing bullying by students. Amends TCA Title 49.	Monitor
SB1184 HB0424	Crowe Hargett	S:Education H:Education	Education – Grants access to certain information about public high school students to official recruiting representatives of U. S. armed forces and Tennessee national guard. Amends TCA Title 49.	Oppose
SB1117 HB0432	Finney, et al Campfield	S:Education H:Education	Education, Higher – Specifies students' rights to academic freedom, freedom from discrimination based on political or religious beliefs, and the right to information concerning grievance procedures; directs THEC to develop and enforce statewide institutional grievance procedure. Amends TCA Title 49, Chapter 7.	Oppose
HJR0096	Campfield, et al	Education	General Assembly, Statement of Intent or Position – Urges adoption of Academic Bill of rights for Public Higher Education	Oppose
