Overview

In Rutherford County, county commissioners and city council members appoint the library board members and board chair of the Rutherford County Library Board – who make library system budget recommendations, set library policies, make the decisions about which books can be removed and restricted from libraries, and can hire and fire the library system director.

The ACLU of Tennessee sent a questionnaire on book bans to all Rutherford County Commission candidates who had email addresses publicly available. Our goal is to promote voter education and voter participation. The ACLU does not endorse or oppose candidates, but we do want to give you the information you need to make informed decisions. Information below is from the candidate questionnaire we distributed to all candidates, unless otherwise noted. If a candidate did not complete the questionnaire, the ACLU of Tennessee attempted to find any relevant votes the candidate may have taken, or other publicly available information related to the questions at issue.

Candidate answers are presented here exactly as they were submitted to ACLU of Tennessee, without any editing.

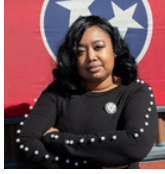

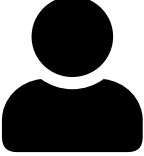
