PEOPLE LIVING WITH HIV/AIDS

According to T.C.A. § 68-10-113, AIDS, among other STD records rightfully retained by health departments are <u>confidential</u> and can only be disclosed under the following conditions:

- The records can be released, with identity withheld, for statistical purposes.
- The records can be released if persons identified in the records consent to the release.
- The records can be released to medical personnel in the event of a medical emergency.
- The records can be released during legal proceedings if so ordered by a trial court judge or by a juvenile court judge.
- If the person identified in the record is a minor under 13 years of age, only the name, age, and address may be released to the appropriate agents.

DISCRIMINATION BASED ON HIV STATUS

The U.S. Supreme Court has held that under the Americans with Disabilities Act, it is illegal to discriminate based on HIV status. An older federal law – the Rehabilitation Act of 1937 (29 USC 701-797) – prohibits discrimination against persons with disabilities by the federal government or by entities receiving federal funding.
