VICTIMS' RIGHTS

Only the government - not crime victims - may press charges and prosecute crimes. However, crime victims have a right to sue the alleged criminal in a civil action for whatever damages they have suffered from the crime.

In November of 1998, Tennessee voters approved an amendment to the Tennessee Constitution providing for victims' rights in Article 1, Section 35 of the Constitution. Some of these rights include the right to "be free from intimidation, harassment and abuse throughout the criminal justice system," the right to "be informed of all proceedings," and the right to "be heard, when relevant, at all critical stages of the criminal justice process."

Victims of some crimes, primarily violence and personal injury, may receive financial compensation from the Criminal Injuries Compensation Act (T.C.A. §29-13-101). This program is intended to provide financial assistance to innocent victims or the dependents of deceased victims in cases where the victim has sustained bodily injury or death as a direct result of violent crime. If you wish to file for compensation, you should contact the Division of Claims Administration. Persons under age 18 must have a legal guardian acting as the claimant. For further information on Victims' rights contact your local District Attorneys office, many have victim advocates among other useful resources.
