Bill	Bill Description	Bill Status	Position
<a href="#">SB 0155 (Green)</a> <a href="#">HB 0271 (Goins)</a>	As introduced, prohibits the adoption of sanctuary policy within cities in the state of Tennessee. Requires the attorney general to receive complaints related to violations of this policy. Requires the state to withhold all funding from any entity that is found to have violated this policy. Defines terms relative to the sanctuary of illegal immigrants and the enforcement of federal immigration laws.	<a href="#">Current Status</a>	Oppose
<a href="#">SB 0272 (Beavers)</a> <a href="#">HB 0222 (Ragan)</a>	As introduced, must include “NON U.S. CITIZEN” or “ALIEN” or a symbol on temporary driver licenses, permits, or identification showing person is not a U.S. citizen or lawful permanent resident of the U.S., expires when person’s work visa or other temporary authorization expires.	<a href="#">Current Status</a>	Oppose
<a href="#">SB 0507 (Gardenhire)</a> <a href="#">HB 0687 (VanHuss)</a>	As introduced, requires the mayor and chief law enforcement officer of a municipality to submit an oath to the comptroller of the treasury committing to assist the United States in the enforcement of all criminal and immigration laws in order to receive its allocation of the state sales tax.	<a href="#">Current Status</a>	Oppose
<a href="#">SB 1014 (Gardenhire)</a> <a href="#">HB 0863 (White, M)</a>	As introduced, exempts certain students from payment of out-of-state tuition at state institutions of higher education.	<a href="#">Current Status</a>	Support
<a href="#">SB 1260 (Norris)</a> <a href="#">HB 1041 (Gant)</a>	As introduced, establishes a sentencing enhancement factor for defendants who are aliens illegally or unlawfully in the United States and who have previously been deported for committing a criminal offense.	<a href="#">Current Status</a>	Oppose
