Re: Juvenile Justice Center Security Procedures

1. I have directed my security staff, both the Juvenile Court Warrant Division and our security contractor, G4S/Wackenhut, to adhere to the prescribed policy in the event that a person or persons, male or female, enter the Juvenile Justice Center wearing any type of headwear. The person in question will be respectfully requested to remove the headwear for security screening. If the person declines to remove the headwear in public, he or she can be screened by a same sex guard in a private room. Once cleared through security, if the headwear can be reasonably ascertained to be of a religious nature, the person will be permitted to replace the headwear and continue with court business. If there is any question as to the nature of the headwear, maximum accommodation is to be afforded.
