action may, as a practical matter, impair or impede the intervening Plaintiffs' ability to protect that interest; the intervening Plaintiffs' claims and the main action have questions of law or fact in common and the action of the intervenors will not unduly delay or prejudice the adjudication of the rights of the original parties.

The intervenors have expended considerable time and effort to date in preparing a challenge to the City Ordinance and as the preeminent national organization in the defense of First Amendment rights and as a member of the National Coalition Against Censorship, can adequately present the issues for a proper determination by the Court.
