PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION ORDER


Pending before the court is Plaintiffs' Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Docket No. 98). For the reasons stated in the accompanying Memorandum, Plaintiffs' Motion is GRANTED.

It is, therefore, ordered, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 65, that Defendants Rutherford County and Lynn Duke, and their officers, agents, employees, servants, attorneys, and all persons in active concert or participation with them are hereby enjoined and restrained from placing juveniles in the Rutherford County Juvenile Detention Facility in solitary confinement or otherwise isolating them from meaningful contact with their peers as punishment or discipline, pending further order of the court.

The court will not require Plaintiffs, under Fed. R. Civ. P. 65(c), to post a bond in this matter.

This preliminary injunction is effective upon its issuance on March 23, 2017.
