

Resolution No.

A Resolution requesting the Metropolitan Nashville Public School Board adopt policies in-line with federal law.

WHEREAS, Congress passed the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) in 1974; and

WHEREAS, FERPA prohibits the disclosure of student records with the consent of both the student and their legal guardian; and

WHEREAS, Metropolitan Nashville Public Schools (MNPS) are subject to the authority of FERPA due to receiving federal funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE METROPOLITAN GOVERNMENT OF NASHVILLE AND DAVIDSON COUNTY:

Section 1. MNPS is requested to adopt policies, in-line with federal law, to prohibit the unauthorized disclosure of any student or family information in violation with federal law; including the disclosure of civil immigration status.

Section 2. This Resolution shall take effect from and after its adoption, the welfare of the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County requiring it.
