**ORDER LIFTING STAY OF PROCEEDINGS AND SETTING HEARING DATE**

The Court finds there is good cause to lift the stay of proceedings in this Matter and to set a hearing date for the pending Motion for Stay of Agency Decision, and any motion to dissolve the injunction that Defendant-Respondents may file.

1. The Plaintiff-Petitioners' ("Petitioners") Renewed Petition for Judicial Review and Declaratory Judgment was filed with the Court on May 12, 2025.
2. Petitioners' Motion for Stay of Agency Decision was filed with the Court on that same date.
3. A status conference was held in this Matter on June 3, 2025.
4. Defendant-Respondents ("Respondents") indicated at the status conference that they intend to file a motion to dissolve the temporary injunction and to file a response to Petitioners' motion to stay.

**IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED** that the Parties' Joint Motion to Lift Stay of Proceedings is GRANTED, and:

1. The motion to stay and any motion to dissolve the injunction are set for hearing on July 22, 2025, at 9:30 AM.
2. The briefing schedule regarding this hearing will be as follows:
  - a. Respondents will file a response to Petitioners' motion to stay the agency decision and any motion to dissolve by July 1, 2025;
  - b. Petitioners will be permitted to file a reply to the motion to stay agency decision, and a response to any motion to dissolve filed by Respondents by July 9, 2025;
  - c. Respondents will be permitted to file a reply to Petitioners' response to any motion to dissolve by July 16, 2025.
