## ORDER LIFTING STAY OF PROCEEDINGS AND SETTING HEARING DATE

- 2. Petitioners' Motion for Stay of Agency Decision was filed with the Court on that same date.
- 3. A status conference was held in this Matter on June 3, 2025.
- 4. Defendant-Respondents ("Respondents") indicated at the status conference that they intend to file a motion to dissolve the temporary injunction and to file a response to Petitioners' motion to stay.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Parties' Joint Motion to Lift Stay of Proceedings is GRANTED, and:

- 1. The motion to stay and any motion to dissolve the injunction are set for hearing on July 22, 2025, at 9:30 AM.
- 2. The briefing schedule regarding this hearing will be as follows:
  - a. Respondents will file a response to Petitioners' motion to stay the agency decision and any motion to dissolve by July 1, 2025;
  - b. Petitioners will be permitted to file a reply to the motion to stay agency decision, and a response to any motion to dissolve filed by Respondents by July 9, 2025;
  - c. Respondents will be permitted to file a reply to Petitioners' response to any motion to dissolve by July 16, 2025.
