


Nearly 60% of misdemeanor defendants remained in jail for the duration of their trial.



## How Nashville Stacks Up


Percentage of Misdemeanor Detainees Jailed Prior to Trial




#### Pretrial detention increases the likelihood of conviction, the likelihood of a jail sentence, and the length of the sentence imposed

#### A federal court recently halted Harris County, Texas, from money bail practices that are virtually the same as Davidson County's.


A Waste of Money


University of Pennsylvania researchers estimated that, had Harris County released only those individuals assigned the lowest amount of money bail, the county could have saved upwards of \$20 million.


